BACKGROUND

The Library is a political subdivision of the State of Missouri. The Board of Trustees (“Board of Trustees”) of the Library is a body corporate with all the powers and rights of like or similar corporations serving more than 405,000 residents.

All management and control of the Library is vested in a Board of Trustees consisting of nine Trustees appointed by the County Executive of St. Charles County or Mayor of the City of St. Charles. The Trustees serve staggered three-year terms.

The Board of Trustees appoints a qualified librarian who holds that office at the Board of Trustees’ pleasure as the Chief Executive Officer (“CEO”) of the Library.

As a condition to the contract award, the selected company is required to enter into a contract with the Library substantially in the form of a Professional Services Agreement.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The Project is subject to all applicable laws of the State of Missouri governing the Library including but not limited to the following:

- Missouri law prohibits all employers from employing aliens unlawfully present in the United States to perform work within the State of Missouri, including the Project and proposers must comply with the provisions relating thereto in Section 285.530, RSMo., as amended.
- Every transient employer must comply with Sections 285.230 through 285.234, RSMo., as amended, when applicable.
- Pursuant to Sections 34.070 and 34.073, RSMo., the Library prefers to purchase those materials, products and supplies which are produced, manufactured, compounded, made, or grown, within the State of Missouri when they are found in marketable quantities and are a quality suited to the purpose intended, and can be secured without additional cost over out-of-state products. Quality and fitness of articles will be considered in making purchases or letting contracts. Similarly, in letting contracts for the performance of any job or services, the Library prefers Missouri firms, corporations or individuals, or firms, corporations or individuals which maintain Missouri offices, when the quality of performance promised is equal and the price quoted is the same or less. Public entities, as well as the successful proposer, shall comply with these laws. Failure to comply with many of these laws constitutes a misdemeanor for the successful proposer. The purpose of these laws is to protect the taxpayers and ensure workplace safety.

In addition to the general requirements listed above, the successful proposer shall comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, applicable zoning and building requirements, and orders of federal, state, county, and local governing authorities pertaining and applicable to each Library location, the successful proposer and/or the Library.

Applicable insurance coverage must be provided by the successful proposer before any work can be started on the Project.

These general requirements, this Request for Proposals, the Proposal and any specifications, drawings, schedules and instructions of the Project shall be incorporated in the contract and/or purchase order signed by the parties should the proposer be awarded a contract under this Request for Proposals.

SCOPE OF WORK

The Library seeks proposals from qualified and experienced companies to provide snow /ice removal and ice melt services for nine (9) branch locations, one (1) Central Services building, and one (1) Bookmobile Stop located in Portage Des Sioux (see Appendix A for location information).

SPECIFICATIONS

Snow/Ice Removal and Ice Melt Services from parking lots, entrances/exits to parking lots, sidewalks and walkways (municipal and private).

- Contractor must provide supervision, labor, equipment and materials.
- Primary snow/ice removal should occur as soon as snow accumulates.
- Services during opening hours should occur when 1 inch has fallen or pavement is icing and/or as weather and surface conditions dictate services to maintain safe conditions.
- Overnight Accumulation must be cleared by 1 hour prior to staff arrival for opening of business unless the library notifies the company that it will be closed or delay opening.
- Contractors will continue to monitor lots in the event of a continuing snowfall and provide services as needed per the guidelines.
- Contactors must be able to provide services within 2 hours of an emergency service call. Contractor must provide an approximate response time.

Terms and Conditions

1. The Contractor warrants that sufficient equipment in good working order and manpower is/will be available to ensure timely completion of the work. In the event of mechanical breakdown, the Contractor will immediately notify designated SCCCL representative(s). The Library reserves the rights to deploy secondary contractors to fill gaps.
2. The Contractor shall use their own employees and vehicles. Vehicles must be easily identified with company logos. **NOTE: Subcontracting of snow/ice removal and ice melt services contract is not allowed.**
3. Damage to irrigation heads, parking blocks, sidewalks, speed humps/bumps, signs, or curbs as a result of plowing activity will be repaired at the Contractor's expense, and per the libraries schedule.
4. If any parking blocks, signs, speed humps/bumps, or curbing are moved during the plowing process the Contractor will put these devices back in place and make necessary repairs.
5. The Contractor must coordinate snow and /or ice removal services with the designated SCCCL representative(s) prior to any /all snow and /or ice removal service is provided. During SCCCL normal business hours, Contractor will provide feedback in real time. After hours, Contractor shall provide confirmation when work

is complete and provide status reports as requested at each site. In any case the Contractor is responsible for the feedback to the SCCCL. Failure to provide feedback could result in invoices not being paid.

6. If the Contractor is unable to respond within two (2) hours due to weather conditions, the Contractor must notify the designated SCCCL representative(s) of approximate response time. The Library reserves the rights to deploy secondary contractors to fill gaps.
7. During business hours, snow/ice removal and ice melt services must be completed at each location no later than **2 hours** after snow stops.
8. The Contractor must take a picture and transmit to the library after each plowing or salting has been completed at each facility.
9. Snow may be stacked in accordance with good plowing practice, where it causes the least interruption of normal traffic flow and fills the fewest number of available parking spots. If snow is stacked inappropriately, the Contractor may be asked to move the snow at no charge to the Library.
10. Contractor should list chemicals to be used to treat parking lots, sidewalks/walkways, and pavers on the cost sheet.
11. Snow and/or ice should not be piled in front of or behind any dumpster, or any location that will interfere with access to the dumpster either by employees or the waste hauler.
12. All ice melt products must be spread by hand spreader or walk behind the spreader. Spreaders shall have adjustable guards to prevent excessive salt or calcium being spread on the grass areas. Truck mount salt spreaders may be used for the open areas of the parking lots.
13. A mixture of salt and calcium chloride may be necessary for pretreatment before and treatment during an ice storm. Expectation during any type of ice storm is that all walkways are reasonably clear of ice to prevent any slips, trips, or falls from our customers or employees. The initial pretreatment needs to be completed prior to the winter storm hitting the area.
14. Sidewalks and walkways shall be treated with calcium chloride or approved alternative only AFTER clearing all fallen snow.
15. ADA parking spaces and curb ramps shall receive priority cleaning. ADA parking spaces and curb ramps are to be cleared on every trip, regardless of the scope of other activities. At no time is plowed snow to be left in an ADA parking space.
16. A complete list of chemicals/deicing agents to be used, including potential alternate chemicals (if any), manufacturer/supplier and suggested coverage amounts shall be specified with proposal. All chemicals and deicing agents shall be applied in adequate amounts, not to fall below the chemical manufacturers recommendation.

Qualifications:

1. Preference will be given to contractors located in and dispatched from St. Charles County.
2. List three (3) local commercial references which the Contractor has performed snow/ice removal and ice melt services for at no less than three (3) consecutive years. SCCCL can be listed as one of the references if the Snow/Ice Removal and Ice Melt Services contractor has done business with the Library in the past five (5) years.
3. Provide a single telephone number which can be called 24/7 during the winter season. This will mainly be used for sending and receiving communication about the plowing status of all branches for which the Contractor is responsible.
5. If you are interested in providing service for more than one group, please demonstrate your company's ability to handle the groups and ability to meet the time frames for servicing the groupings.
6. The Bidder must own enough equipment and manpower to provide these services. Contractor must provide a descriptive list of equipment and number of equipment operators that will be used to provide required services. This contract requires Bidder to have a reasonable type of snow throwing equipment.

Invoices:

1. Invoices must be prepared on a "per event" basis. An event is defined as any 24-hour period, commencing at midnight and ending at 11:59 p.m.
2. Invoices must be itemized by branch, date, time, weather conditions and type of service performed.

PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

1. The RFP Response Packet (see Appendix A) must arrive no later than 2:00 pm. C.T. on Tuesday, March 10, 2026. No proposal will be accepted after this time and any proposal arriving after this time will be discarded.

Oral explanations or instructions given before the award of the contract will not be binding. Any information given to a proposer concerning a solicitation will be published as an addendum to the Request for Proposals and posted on the Library website at <https://www.stchlibrary.org/bids-and-rfps>.
5. The Library is not liable for any cost incurred by the proposer prior to issuance of a legally executed contract by the Library and/or purchase order authorized by the Library.
6. All materials submitted by the proposer in response to this Request for Proposals become the sole property of the Library upon receipt. The material contained in these Proposals will be appended to the final contract, further defining the contractual responsibilities of the proposer.

PROPOSAL CONTENT

The Proposal shall contain the following information at a minimum:

1. Contractor Questionnaire. Proposer must complete and submit the Contractor Questionnaire provided in Appendix A of this RFP. The Contractor Questionnaire includes:
 - a. Company Information: Please provide the company name and RFP contact information including address, phone, email.
 - b. Experience/Technical Summary: Please provide experience relevant to the RFP.
 - c. Quality Assurance Procedures: Please provide information about the company's quality assurance procedures.
 - d. References: Please provide at least three (3) references from similar sized contracts pursuant to which your company has provided similar services within the last five (5) years.
 - e. Conflict of Interest: If the proposer believes that a conflict of interest may arise, describe the nature of the conflict and the proposed resolution of the conflict. Further, please describe whether the firm or any of its employees has any interests or relationships which might conflict with or compromise the expectations of the Library in providing the services set forth in this Request for Proposals.
 - f. Financial Interest: Please disclose any professional or personal financial interests which could be a possible conflict of interest in contracting to perform services for the Library.
 - g. Other: When bidding on more than one group, describe the company's approach to providing services to multiple groups (number of trucks, number of people, equipment, etc.). Discuss any other firm characteristics which your firm believes should be considered by the Library.

2. Cost Sheet. Using the cost sheets presented in Appendix A, the proposer must submit a fee for the Project services that is inclusive of all costs. Proposer should incorporate any overhead into the fee including, without limitation, supplies, equipment, telephone, mileage and other charges.

SELECTION PROCEDURES

1. Proposals will be opened and referred to and reviewed by a Selection Committee composed of representatives of the Library named by the CEO.
2. Proposals that fail to adhere to the requirements of this Request for Proposals may result in the Proposal being disqualified as non-responsive.
3. In determining the best Proposal, among other factors, the Library may consider all factors in this Request for Proposals including, but not limited to the capacity and capability of proposer to perform the work in question within the time limitations required; proposer's past experiences with references for comparable work; location of the proposer; and the reasonableness of the fee for the type of work required.
4. If required under the provisions of the Library's purchasing policies or professional services, the Selection Committee will make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees.

AWARD

1. The right is reserved by the Board of Trustees to cancel this Request for Proposals, to reject any and all Proposals, to split awards or make multiple awards, or to waive formalities in the best interest of the Library.
2. Subject to the rights reserved by the Library, an award will be made by the Board of Trustees to the proposer determined to have the best Proposal.
3. All proposers will be notified of the Library's selection as soon as possible.
4. The successful proposer will be issued a Notice of Award. Within ten business days, the successful proposer shall provide the following documentation:
5. Proof of the appropriate insurance coverage:
 - Worker's Compensation & Employers Liability – statutory amounts
 - Commercial General Liability – \$1,000,000/occurrence
\$2,000,000/aggregate
 - Automobile Liability Insurance – \$1,000,000
 - Professional Liability – \$1,000,000
 - Umbrella Liability Insurance – \$5,000,000/occurrence
6. Federal Identification Number.
7. Evidence that the successful proposer is authorized to do business in Missouri.
8. All proposers on Library contracts for services in excess of \$5,000 must provide the Library with documentation and a sworn affidavit, with respect to employees working in connection with the contracted services, affirming enrollment in a

Federal Work Authorization Program (“FWAP”). The affidavit shall also provide that the proposer does not knowingly employ any person in connection with the contracted services who is an unauthorized alien. Such affidavits must be provided with a Proposal. Subcontractors must provide similar affidavits to its general contractors when the general contractor hires the subcontractor. A contractor or subcontractor is not required to perform an electronic verification check on employees hired before January 1, 2009.

9. The contract shall commence on July 1, 2026.

The successful proposer is expected to enter into a written contract with the Library. The contract will be substantially in the form of the Snow/Ice Removal and Ice Melt Services Agreement. Approval of a final contract between the Library and the successful proposer, pursuant to this Request for Proposals and the proposer’s response, may be subject to approval by the Board of Trustees.
